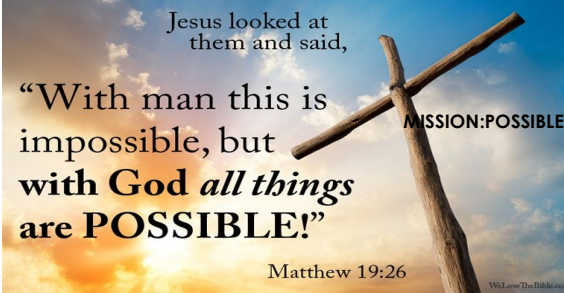
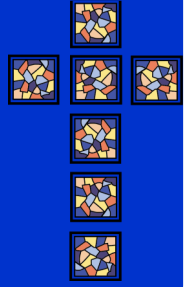

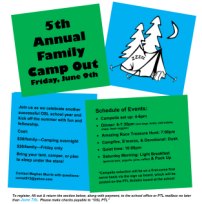
## NEWS FROM PRINCIPAL COUSER

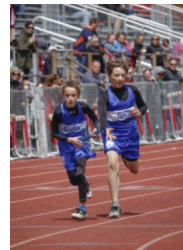
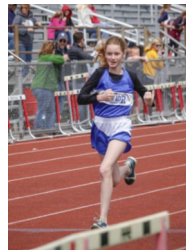
