## What is **SCRIP**?

- OSL tuition credit for your student(s)
- Support for ministry at Our Savior
- Gift cards
- No extra charge for you

## Why **SCRIP**?

- 50% of proceeds from your purchases by May 1st are credited to next year's tuition.
- 50% supports the ministry at Our Savior.
- Friends and relatives SCRIP proceeds may be designated to a student/family.
- No minimum order requirements.
- Over 300 retailers!

## Daily Scrip Use Examples

- **Groceries:** Meijer, Sam's Club, Target, Walmart
- **Gas:** BP, Exxon, Marathon, Shell, Speedway
- **Shopping:** Amazon, Kohl's, Dick's Sporting Goods, Macy's, TJMaxx/Marshalls
- **Entertainment:** Celebration Cinema, Regal Cinema, Disney, Comfort Inn
- **Eating out:** Wendy's, Taco Bell, Cracker Barrel, Bob Evans, Outback, Subway

# HOW SCRIP WORKS in 3 simple steps

1. OSL buys store issued gift cards from Great Lakes Scrip at a discount.
  - OSL buys a \$25 Applebee's card for \$23.50
2. You purchase at face value.
  - You pay \$25.00 for the card
3. You and OSL split the difference.
  - \$2.50 difference= \$1.25 for tuition and \$1.25 for OSL

Scrip (example)	Monthly Spending	Monthly Rebates	Annual Rebates
Groceries	\$426	\$21.30	\$240
Gas	\$300	\$12.00	\$144
Clothing	\$163	\$7.36	\$88.32
Dining out	\$310	\$27.90	\$334.8
Entertainment	\$92	\$7.36	\$88.32
Totals	\$1291	\$83.23	\$983.00

50% goes to family tuition: \$491.00  
 50% goes to OSL Ministry: \$491.00
