Discover Our Savior Class

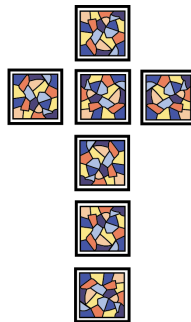
Wednesdays at 6:30pm beginning January 9th
