Using any smart phone, text any amount to (517) 268-8220. You'll receive a response with a link to set up a secure account. Click on that link to fill in the required information. Then click "Submit". You'll receive a text once your gift is complete. After your first gift is complete, to make another donation, simply text the amount you want to give to the same number. The gift will automatically be charged to the previously used method. We encourage you to save this number to your phone as "OSL Giving" (or something you'll recognize) so that you'll have this number handy for next time! And don't forget, you can always set up a reoccurring online gift by going to oursaviorlansing.org/giving.
