****TOGETHER CAPITAL CAMPAIGN KICK-OFF:** Today marks the beginning of our Capital Campaign called "TOGETHER: In Christ, with Hope, for the Next Generation." Our goal is to raise \$1.3 million over the next three years to support the dynamic and growing ministry of our church and school. Materials were mailed to members' homes and are available in the church lobby for prayerful consideration. A devotion booklet leads us in prayer and God's Word as we grow in faith and generosity through this campaign.

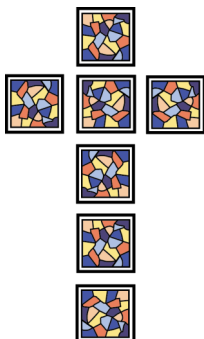
