Readings: Galatians 6:1-10; Matthew 12:46-50

The focus passage for this week is *Galatians 6:1-10*. Read through that passage of the Bible, and then work through the questions and then the challenge for the week, learning what the church is throughout this sermon series.

- 1. How do you react when you are caught in a sin, or catch someone sinning?
- 2. In what ways can you live out the church's calling to bear with one another's' burdens as you interact with your family members especially those in your Church Family?

Weekly challenge: The Church is a family of believers called to live among one another. This week you are challenged to acknowledge and celebrate each family member's uniqueness and strengths and relate that to the variety of different types of people that make up your community, such as your neighbors, your friends, or your extended family members. This can teach us tolerance, awareness, and respect that can be used to value everyone equally.
