Our Savior Lutheran Church and School Response to Heightened Health Concern

Due to the heightened health concerns regarding the spread of COVID-19 in Michigan, Our Savior Lutheran Church and School is taking the following precautionary measures:

- Masks are required for anyone over the age of 2 years old
- Everyone will be asked to <u>fill out a connecting card</u> and <u>wash their hands</u> before entering. No exceptions.
- We are suspending the <u>sharing of the peace</u> and the use of <u>doorway</u> greeters during worship services.
- Households are asked to sit at least <u>four pew cushions apart</u> to observe social distancing.
- Offering will be collected at the door as people leave.
- Special instructions will be given for Holy Communion.
- Pews and Communion Stations are <u>wiped down</u> after each service with anti-bacterial wipes
- As many doors as we can <u>prop open</u> will be left open to avoid high contact areas

Holy Communion is offered on the 1st and 3rd Sundays, and each Monday evening in July & August, as God blesses His people with Word and Sacrament to strengthen our faith for such a time as this. Special health measures will apply.

All members and visitors are encouraged to:

- Wash your hands upon entering the church
- Stay at home if you are ill
- Wear masks inside the building
- Greet, encourage, and care for one another with the love of Christ.
