Infant Faith Chest Milestone

Parents who are expecting as well as parents of children under 2 years old are invited to the Infant Faith Chest Milestone Class to enhance faith development in their young one. They will be able to share meaningful examples of baptism gifts, scriptures, and other gifts that will remind children of their baptism into Christ as they grow. The class will take place Thursday, September 10, via Zoom from 8:00pm-9:00pm. If you would like to participate in this milestone, please request an invite prior to September 9th. A special worship blessing will take place on Sunday, September 13 during the 8:30 and 10:30am services. A faith chest will be given to each family that attends this milestone class. The purpose of the faith chest is to store keepsakes, and baptismal reminders such as baptismal candle, crosses, baptism gifts, and other items of significance as the child grows. The faith chests are not painted or stained, and our fine craftsmen from OSL will imprint your child's name and baptism birth date inside the cover of the faith chest if you desire. You are then free to take home the faith chest and finish it with any stain and varnish that you choose.
