Join Us Tuesday Evenings, 7–8pm, beginning January 11th, 2022 (ends: March 1st, 2022). "Be Still and Know: A Study of Rest and Refuge" by Deb Burma, unpacks the promises found in Psalm 46 that are fulfilled in Christ. The first session looks at Psalm
